### Our Mission

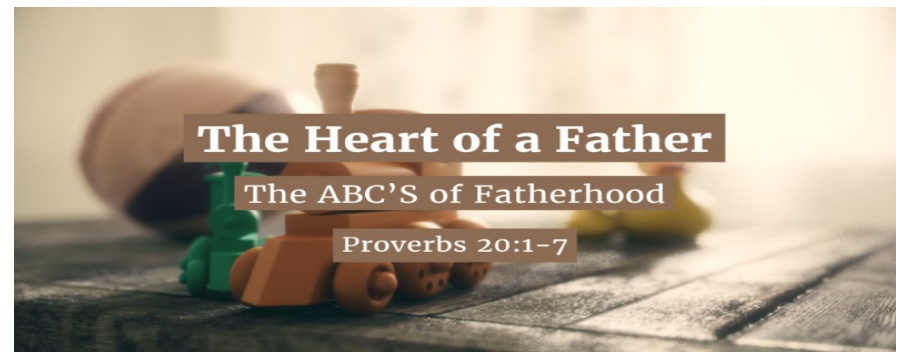
Develop Jesus-centered followers who are committed to helping usher in the Kingdom of God so that everyone can experience the love of Jesus and help change the world.
