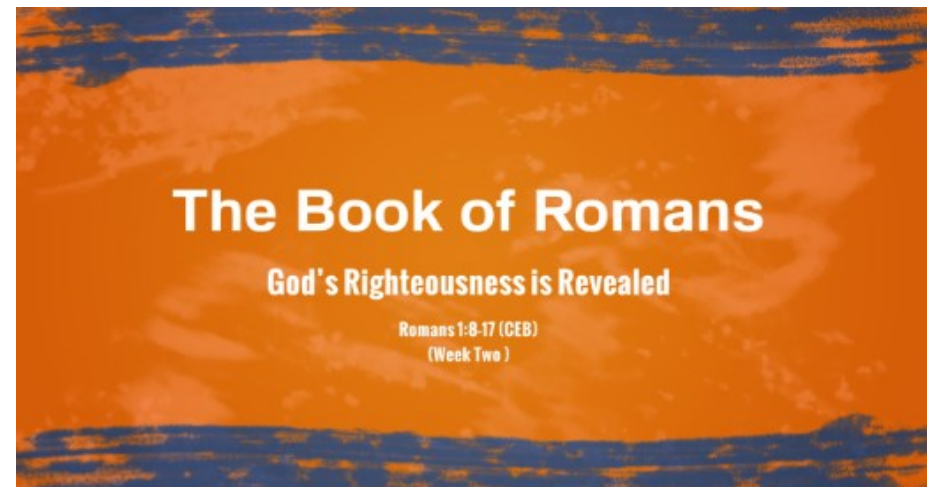

7. To answer the following questions, refer to the later portion of the book of Acts. Did Paul eventually visit Rome? If so, when, and under what circumstances?
8. Read Romans 1 and meditate on verse 16 and 17. Are you ever *"ashamed of the gospel"*? If so, when? What normally prompts this embarrassing response?
9. How does Paul define *"the gospel"* in Romans 1:16? What does the gospel reveal (Romans 1:17)? What does Paul mean when he says, *"The righteous person will live by faith"*?
