Today’s Reflection Questions: (Individual or Small Group)

- What stood out, encouraged, or challenged you from this week’s message?
- Read Romans 2. Verses 17-29 explain why a “Jew,” or trusting in “the Law,” or “circumcision,” cannot make a person right with God. Why would an unsaved Jew in Paul’s day, or even our day, have a problem with this teaching?
- From 2:17-24, James 2:10, and Romans 3:28, why are Jews unable to obtain a right standing with God so long as they trust in the Law for salvation? What do verses 23 and 24 communicate regarding the witness of a person living under the Law? Do you detect a lack of joy in their lives? According to 2 Corinthians 3:6, why does this exist?
- According to Romans 2:25, under what condition can “circumcision” make a person right with God? Has anyone lived up to this standard outside of Jesus?

- Verses 26-27 are extremely interesting. Paul contrasts the unbelieving Jew who is circumcised with the uncircumcised Gentile who is a believer. When we accept Jesus as Savior in our depraved state, God makes us new and justifies us, that is, makes us not guilty before Him. From then on He sees us as having kept the Law perfectly. He also sends the Holy Spirit to direct our lives, which allows our behavior to begin to line up with the righteous standard of the Law (Romans 8:4)—a topic addressed in much depth in the weeks ahead. With this in mind, record what verses 26-27 communicate with you.
- Who is a true “Jew” (Romans 2:28-29)? Does this mean that God is no longer concerned with fulfilling the unconditional covenants He made with the physical Jewish nation? Think long and hard before answering.
- Would you rather be praised by man or by God (v.29)? What encouraged you the most from Romans 2? Record your thoughts and study Romans 3. Hopefully as we unpack Chapter 3 it will shed new light on some of your unanswered questions.
