

# **Today's Reflection Questions: (Individual or Small Group)**

- What stood out, encouraged, or challenged you from this week's message?
- Read Romans 3:1-8. Verse 3 asks an extremely interesting question. Will God's "faithfulness," His "faithfulness," to the Jews who repent and believe while lost, be nullified if a great number of Jews prove to be unfaithful by rejecting Jesus? Why would the unbelieving Jew ask such a question?
- Write down at least one instance in the Old Testament where God was faithful to the believing remnant of the Jews when the majority of the nation remained in unbelief. Many exist, so take your pick.
- Do you picture God as a faithful God? Read 2 Timothy 1:12, 1 Corinthians 10:13, 1 Corinthians 1:9, 1 Thessalonians 5:24, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, Hebrews 2:17, Hebrews 3:6, Hebrews 10:23, Hebrews 11:11, 1 Peter 4:19, 1 Peter 4:19, 1 John 1:9, Revelation 1:5, Revelation 19:11, and Revelation 21:5 to grasp the New Testament Scripture declares regarding His faithfulness. How do these verses encourage you?

- Many verses in God's Word describe God's faithfulness. Which verse encourages you the most?
- Based on Romans 3:4, what was Paul's opinion of God's faithfulness?
- If the sin of humankind should demonstrate God's righteousness, in other words bring glory to God, could God judge the lost and remain just? If not, why not?
- In Romans 3:6, Paul answers the question of Romans 3:5. We understand from verse 6 that God will "judge the world." What judgment is Paul indicating if "the world" points to the unsaved?
- Romans 3:7-8 are fascinating, for they present the final attempt of the unbelieving Jew to undermine Paul's theology. They reveal the mentality that sometimes results when Law, Churchianity, Religion, etc., is elevated above God's grace. Describe this mindset? Does this not amplify your desire to abandon Law, legalism, churchianity, religion, and bask for God's grace?
